CHANGES TO FUNDING

I am sure that most of you aware of the upcoming changes to funding, but for those of you who would like to learn more, please follow this link: www.childcarechoices.gov. uk/upcoming-changes-to-childcare-support. I have also attached the letter we sent out at the start of January, but please let us know if you have any further questions.

Starting from April 2024, existing childcare support will be expanded in phases. By September 2025, most working families with children under the age of 5 will be entitled to 30 hours of childcare support.

The changes are being introduced gradually to make sure that providers can meet the needs of more families. This means that:

From April 2024, eligible working parents of 2-year-olds will be able to access 15 hours childcare support.

From September 2024, 15 hours childcare support will be extended to eligible working parents of children from the age of 9 months to 3-year-olds.

From September 2025, eligible working parents of children under the age of 5 will be entitled to 30 hours of childcare a week.

SCHOOL ALLOCATION DAY

School allocation day takes place on Tuesday I 6th April. We will work closely with you so that we all can prepare your child appropriately, and, for example, talk to your child about who will be attending the same school as them. This is a good way to link children (and parents) before their move to big school. This is an exciting time and we hope you are all happy with your allocation.
