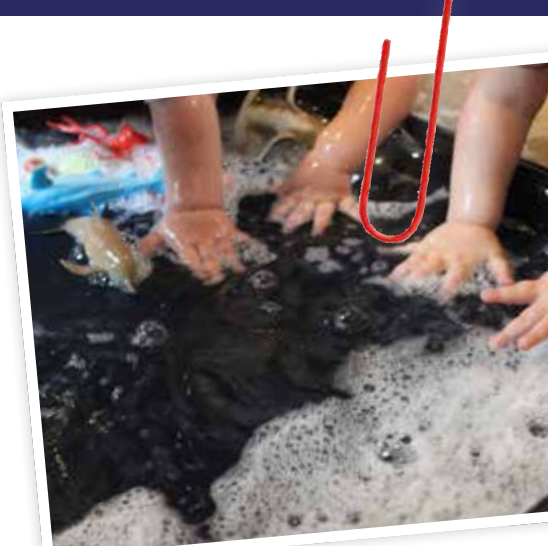
Star of the Month

Discovery Garden

We have been very busy creating a new Discovery Garden, and we are thrilled with it as the children are! There are various exciting zones for the children to explore including a water station, a construction area, a mud kitchen (complete with real pots, pans, herbs and vegetables), and a wobbly path. There is also a creative area - which could sometimes be a dinosaur world, sometimes a farmyard, or perhaps a zoo. There is also a lovely planting area. BEAR CUBS: For baby bears from 3 - 18 months

This month the children have shown plenty of interest in arts and crafts, and one of their favourite activities was painting with different tools such as rollers and brushes. Summer-inspired activities have included sand play, water play and cereal beach play! We are also having fun making coloured ice blocks to use for a mark making activity.



CUDDLY BEARS: For toddler bears 18 - 24 months

The children have enjoyed a variety of books, so we have focussed on activities based around their favourite stories. These have included 'Dear Zoo', 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt', and 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'.

The children enjoyed going on a bear hunt around the nursery, and this activity helped the children to recognise their body parts. We made some cooked spaghetti to look like worms and the children used tweezers to try to pick it up! The children have also enjoyed porridge play with different sized bears, filling and emptying containers, and exploring the texture of the oats. We are going to make our own porridge to explore how textures change.

The children have also enjoyed water play in the garden. They have been washing the dolls and floating ducks whilst singing 'Five Little Ducks Went Swimming One Day!'

For growing bears 2 - 2½

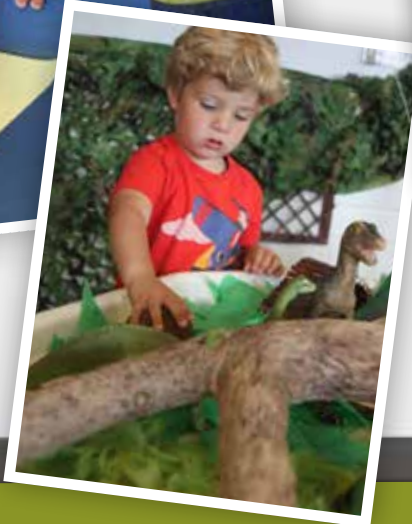
