CURRICULUM

We are making changes to how we record children's learning in nursery. Our aim is to minimise the amount of time staff are spending on paperwork and in turn maximise the amount of time being spent with the children. The changes we have made also help to streamline our current systems as all information is stored in one place: Famly!

Observations and assessments are all now completed on Famly, and we hope that you have witnessed the benefits of this development. The observations, written by our practitioners, will be linked to different areas of learning and our Berkhampstead Day Nursery Curriculum. You can also glean what your child is working towards, here at the Day Nursery, from the "What's Next" comment section.
