NEWS FROM THE HEAD OF SCHOOL

Dear Parents.

It's been such a happy week welcoming all the children back to school, the existing ones as well as our new pupils and the staff. I am sure that the children will soon get used to their new routines, their classrooms and their new friends. Lessons are in full swing and it's been a pleasure to see the children engaged in all of this first week's varied activities. It's also been lovely to see so many parents at the three introductory evenings I have attended with Years 1.2 and 3.

The staff benefitted from a series of excellent inset days before the children returned on Tuesday. Included were two brilliant workshops by external speakers. The exuberant Belinda Heaven delivered one on the 'Trusted Emotionally Available Adult.' Belinda is a mental health first aid trainer and advisor for Gloucestershire Healthy Living and Learning, and has written training manuals for teachers on educating children about mental health. She is well known to our staff and some of our parents, having been into school for previous staff training days, and last term to enlighten parents and staff on how to look after own mental health. Then, at the beginning of this week, Neil Griffiths shared with us his expertise on reading and storytelling. Having been a headteacher for 13 years before taking on the role of director of a National Literacy Support Project for the Basic Skills Agency, his good ideas were received gladly by our School and Day Nursery staff.

While we have been spending time away from school, the estates team have been hard at work improving the facilities for our pupils and staff. The rear of Pre-Prep building has had a wonderful makeover - including the removal of the fire escape, rendering, decorating, new roof tiles and the refurbishment of the window frames - it looks very smart indeed! The kitchen has also received a healthy dose of TLC, and no surface has escaped replacement and improvement. It's a much improved working environment for our brilliant catering department. Meanwhile, across the road on the Prep side, the hall and the cloakroom have also been given smart facelifts. There are new vanity units, loos and urinals, as well as a state-of-the-art 85 inch screen in the hall. The Prep playground has also benefitted during the holiday, with a smart tarmac surface marked out with a netball court. I would like to extend my thanks to Jess Griffiths and her team for the considerable workload they took on over the holiday and the improvement they have delivered for our benefit.

I am delighted that our new Breakfast Club is now up and running. A really useful facility for working parents, it runs from 7.40am and is based in the Pre-Prep hall. Any children who need an early drop-off are able to have breakfast in school - cereals, fruit, yoghurts and toast - before joining their peers in the playground at 8.10am.
