The smaller playground has been resurfaced with 'Play-Grass' artificial turf, featuring a green area for football and a smaller blue section designed for basketball, complete with goals and protective post covers. This upgrade has improved the appearance of the Prep playgrounds and will enhance the children's enjoyment at breaktimes. None of this would have been possible without the incredible generosity of our PTA, who part-funded the project; we are very grateful for their continued support.

NEWS FROM THE HEAD OF SCHOOL CONTINUED

We are extremely pleased with the achievements of our Year 6 pupils this year. From a cohort of 38 children, our pupils performed very well in a year when a vast number of children from schools across the county and beyond sat the grammar school entrance test. An eye-catching 17 pupils who chose to sit the test achieved the qualifying score for local grammar schools including Pate's Grammar School, Sir Thomas Rich's School, Denmark Road High School, Ribston Hall High School, Marling School, The Crypt School and Stroud High School, with places allocated in March. In addition, our oldest pupils have been awarded an incredible 19 scholarships to independent senior schools, spanning academic, art, drama, music and sport.

We are very fortunate in Gloucestershire to have a wealth of excellent senior school options, including state academies, grammar schools, and independent schools. At Berkhampstead, we take great pride in preparing each child for the school that is right for them. Pupils benefit from dedicated critical thinking lessons each week from Year 3 and are carefully supported in preparing for both grammar school entrance and scholarship applications. Parents receive clear guidance throughout the process, including a Future Schools Evening for Years 4 and 5, which this year will take place on Monday 2nd March. Mrs Jenny Hannett, Head of School Transition, works closely with families to ensure each child's next steps are well supported. Additionally, the heads of local secondary schools are invited to Berkhampstead to deliver assemblies for pupils and parents, with a chance to chat to the heads afterwards over coffee. Dates have now been confirmed for our summer holiday grammar school entrance practice sessions for Year 5 pupils: 29th July, and 5th, 19th, and 26th August.

Before Christmas, we carried out an Independent Association of Prep Schools (IAPS) pupil survey with our Prep pupils in Years 3 to 6. I am delighted to share some of the results, which reflect the strength of our school: 99% of pupils said that adults at school care for them, 98% said their teachers encourage pupils to behave well in lessons, and 97% said they feel confident to try something new even if they get it wrong. We are extremely pleased with these excellent outcomes. A parent questionnaire will be sent out later today, and we would be very grateful for your feedback.

This morning, we were delighted to host our Berky Experience Open Morning for prospective Pre-Prep and Early Years families. Parents and children were invited to enjoy a typical morning at Berky, and we hope the event offered valuable insight into our super school.

I wish everyone a very happy and successful Spring Term.

Our Berky Experience Open Morning was a chance for us to share our provision with prospective parents whilst our Kindergarten children took part in a wide array of activities with their teddy bears from home! We loved showcasing what we have to offer.

This cold snap of weather has arrived just in time for our topic of 'We are Polar Explorers'. The children have had a fantastic time exploring with ice in the tuff trays; touching it, feeling it, and finding out what happens when you hit it with a hammer! It has been amazing to see ice forming naturally in our outside water tray, and to watch it change as it melts throughout the day. We have started to learn about the different polar habitats of the North and South Poles, and the types of animals that inhabit them. NEWS FROM RECEPTION

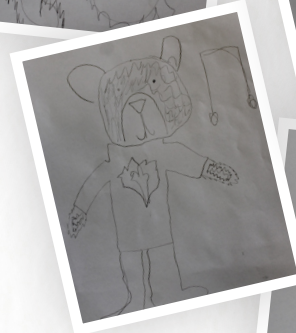
It has been wonderful to welcome the children back after the holidays. They have returned full of enthusiasm and eager to share stories from their magical Christmas break. We have loved seeing the photographs on Tapestry of their favourite books, which range from classic stories to cookery books and science fact books—such a fantastic variety!

This week, we have begun our new topic on toys. The children have enjoyed talking about their oldest and most-loved toys, new toys Santa may have brought, and comparing the toys they play with now to those they had as babies and toddlers. As the term continues, we will explore how toys have changed over time, looking at technological advances, the materials they are made from, and even where they are bought.

In art on Wednesday, the children practised their sketching skills by drawing our much-loved Berky Bear. They carefully observed the teddy beforehand and produced some impressively detailed and accurate drawings. These are now displayed in the Reception corridor and look absolutely wonderful.

In maths, we have been tackling the question: Is zero really a number? The children explored what zero means using number lines, real-life scenarios (often involving chocolate biscuits!), and even the freezing temperatures we have experienced this week.
